Produces Estrogen Houses the Eggs	Ovary
Stores Urine from the body	Bladder
Tube that urine takes to exit the body	Urethra
Bean shaped Highly sensitive part of the body located at base of vagina	Clitoris
Also known as the "birth canal" Muscular part of the reproductive system Place of intercourse Passageway of menstrual flow and arriving sperm	Vagina
Organ that prepares itself each month to receive an egg Nourishes a pregnancy (where a baby grows) Contracts for childbirth	Uterus
3-5 inch tubes that eggs travel through to get to the uterus	Fallopian Tube
Skin that covers and protects the vagina	Labia (Majora) Labia (Minora)
Opening to the uterus	Cervix
