First, deoxygenated blood enters the **right atrium**

Blood leaves the heart by the aortic semilunar valve into the **aorta** and is pumped to the body

Blood travels out the pulmonary semilunar valve and through the **pulmonary trunk and arteries** to the lungs.

Oxygenated blood from the lungs travels through the left **pulmonary veins** and returns to the heart into the **left atrium**.

Blood goes through the tricuspid valve into the **right ventricle.**

Blood goes through the bicuspid valve into the strongest chamber the **left ventricle**.
