

First, deoxygenated blood enters
the **right atrium**

Blood leaves the heart by the
aortic semilunar valve into the
aorta and is pumped to the
body

Blood travels out the pulmonary
semilunar valve and through the
pulmonary trunk and arteries
to the lungs.

Oxygenated blood from the
lungs travels through the left
pulmonary veins and returns to
the heart into the **left atrium**.

Blood goes through the
tricuspid valve into the **right**
ventricle.

Blood goes through the bicuspid
valve into the strongest chamber
the **left ventricle**.
